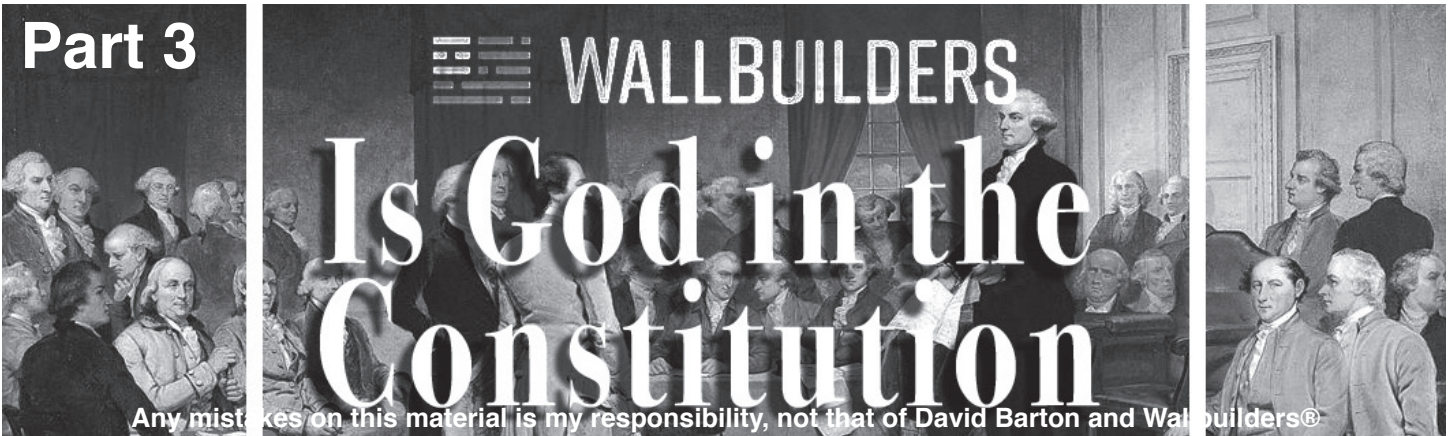


## Part 3
